- Understand and address the systemic barriers that contribute to food insecurity, advocating for equitable policies and practices.
- Actively participate in expanding Fresh Routes' network of customers, sponsors, grantors and champions.
- Attend and patronize Fresh Routes markets as much as possible.

#### **Qualifications:**

- Deep understanding of or lived experience with the challenges faced by underserved communities, particularly regarding food insecurity.
- Strong commitment to equity, diversity, and inclusion, with a willingness to amplify the voices of marginalized groups.
- Excellent communication, interpersonal, and relationship-building skills.

- Willingness to learn and engage with community members and stakeholders to inform decision-making processes.
- Availability to fulfill the responsibilities effectively, with previous board experience considered an asset but not required.

- Quarterly committee meetings, 1 hour in length plus ~1 hour of work outside of meetings
- Annual in-person board social, 2 hours
- Bi-annual network sharing meeting with Fundraising Lead, 1 hour
